



AIRSPACE INFRINGEMENTS AWARENESS COURSE About the Course

The Airspace Infringements Awareness Course is designed as an alternative to the Civil Aviation Authority's online tutorial and examination diverting General Aviation pilots who infringe airspace to a re-educational course rather than flying with a CAA authorised examiner. The course content is designed to change the pilot's behaviour with the aim of preventing airspace infringements.

To qualify for an Airspace Infringements Awareness Course the pilot's infringement needs to be classified as unintentional and where a serious risk of collision did not exist Furthermore, pilots will not be offered an Airspace Infringements Awareness Course if they have taken one in the three years prior to the most recent occurrence. The Process is explained in detail in CAP1404 - Airspace infringements: Review and Actions Process

The Airspace Infringements Awareness Course is a one day theory based workshop designed to help pilots recognise the consequences of airspace infringements, address the reasons for them and provide information designed to help them reduce the likelihood of infringing airspace in the future. Completing the workshop means that pilots will not have to take a check flight with an authorised examiner.

There are up to 24 people on each course and two course trainers. The people attending are of all ages and flying experiences. It is a relaxed setting for them to assess their flying behaviour and gain tips to reduce the likelihood of infringing airspace in the future

Duration: 5¼ hours (including breaks)

There is no flying required.

Content: The course consists of a

four hour interactive presentation and activities including discussions and exercises on all aspects of airspace infringements, in a relaxed and informal

atmosphere.

Venues: The course will normally be

held in convenient hotel conference rooms at

locations throughout the UK. There is sufficient choice of venues and dates offered in order that prospective delegates can find a venue and date that are reasonably

convenient for them
