PURPOSE AND DISCLAIMER

This consolidation sets out the provisions of Implementing Regulation (EU) 923/2012 (the Standardised European Rules of the Air (SERA)), the European Aviation Safety Agency's supporting Acceptable Means of Compliance (AMC) and Guidance Material (GM), specific articles of the Air Navigation Order, The Rules of the Air Regulations 2015 and supporting guidance prepared by the Civil Aviation Authority.

It also contains General Exemptions and General Permissions related to SERA and the Rules of the Air Regulations 2015. The Regulations and specific articles of the Air Navigation Order are in their currently amended form.

It has been prepared for those concerned with day-to-day matters relating to Air Navigation who require an up to date consolidation of the Orders and the Regulations mentioned above. It is edited by the Safety and Airspace Regulation Group of the Civil Aviation Authority. Courts of Law will however refer only to the source regulatory material.
